During this half-day of professional development participants will:

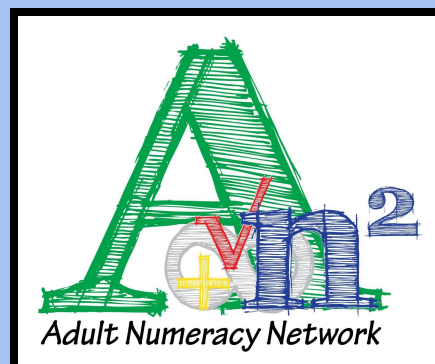
- ★ Explore ways that music and art reflect number sense, proportional reasoning, and symmetry.
